## **ENROLLMENT UPDATE**


There were 34 patients enrolled into LOVIT in August.

# Glucose Measurement with the Statstrip Glucometer – Error Code E-9

If the Nova Biomedical's StatStrip glucometer indicates an error code E-9, it means that the blood sample collected and put on the strip cannot be measured. The glucometer analyses the blood sample before proceeding to the glucose measurement. When it detects something abnormal, the glucometer will indicate an error instead of giving a false glucose value. When the error code E-9 happens, you must stop using the glucometer and use the core lab infrastructure or the point-of-care ABG machine that has been validated in the setting of high plasma concentrations of vitamin C for glucose measurements.
